



Granite Waiver

- Granite is a natural product which is predisposed to flaking, crumbling and chipping which can occur more frequently in exotic material. Sometimes the delicate character of some stone is evident by the mesh backing on the underside of the slab
- Granite is prone to holes, fissures/extrusions (small visual cracks that are not faults within the slab and are refilled with resin or colored filler)
- Exotic stone is delicate and more vulnerable during transport and especially in production. General handling and fabrication procedures such as cut-outs, profiling etc. may amplify the tendency for flaking and chipping, due to the nature of the stone. The surface of the stone is already polished when Burleigh Stone Artisans (BSA) purchases it and can not be altered
- Some granite may require more frequent applications of sealant
- Seams in granite surfaces are visible and can be felt
- Seam locations are at the sole discretion of BSA, unless specified in writing and approved by BSA before production
 - A request to change a seam location may result in a quote revision
- Echelon and artisan edge profiles are not recommended for exotic stone and will make it less durable
- Exotic granite edges cannot be mitered
- Granite is a natural product and as such may have some pitting, fissure and fusions
- Granite slabs are subject to variances in veining, color, shade and texture
